## **FAMILY VIOLENCE WORKSHOPS:**

**Non-Fatal Strangulation in the Domestic Context** 

Strangulation is a key red flag for future lethality in intimate partner violence. In May 2016, the New Zealand Law Commission released its report looking at how best to respond to non-fatal strangulation. The report recommends introducing a new crime of strangulation into the Crimes Act 1961, with a maximum penalty of seven years' imprisonment.

Workshop topics include:

- ♣ Signs, symptoms and best practice in the field of domestic violence
- Documentation
- Recommendations and findings from 2014 Report of the NZ Family Violence Death Review Committee
