

Overall, how would you rate the event?



How organized was the event?



She hadn't been to see a doctor even though she had lost consciousness and she was also afraid that by slapping and biting the assailant she might get into trouble (she also didn't want him charged but Police were going to anyway). I felt confident providing her with evidence-based information and the recommendation that she see her doctor as quickly as possible. I am also encouraging others to attend again in the future and to look up the resources you provided. Are you able to send the Powerpoint for my future reference?
